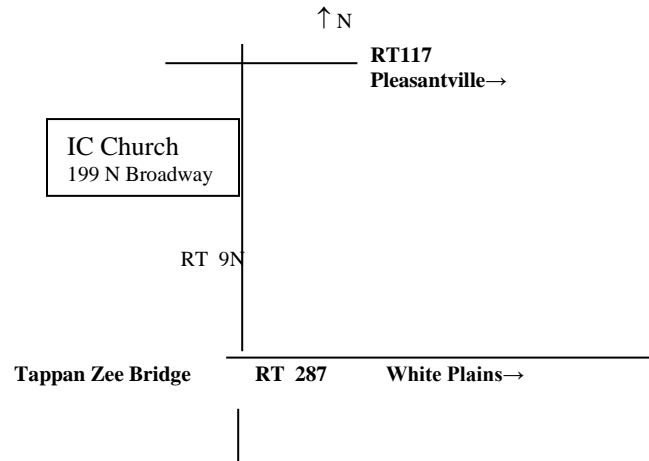

The **National Shrine of the North American Martyrs**, also dedicated as the **Shrine of Our Lady of Martyrs**, is a Roman Catholic shrine in Auriesville, New York dedicated to the Jesuit missionaries who were martyred at the Mohawk Indian village of Ossernenon in 1642 and 1646 and Canada.
