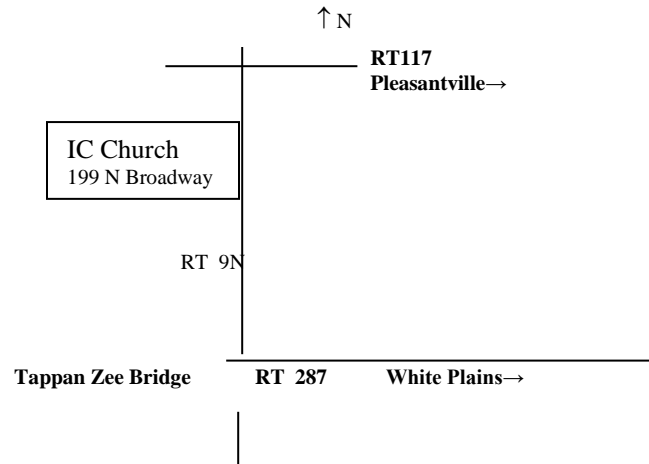

Patriots' Park*



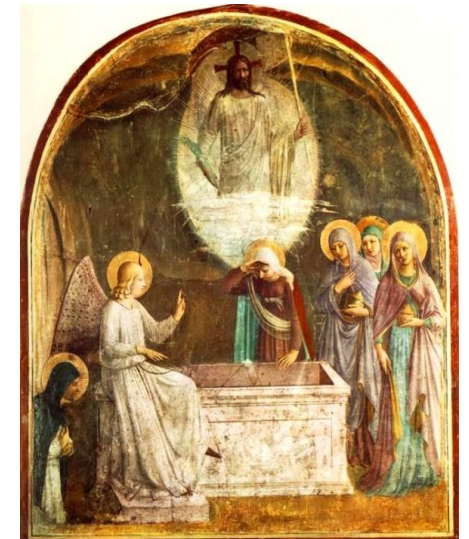
